

INVITATION TO BID

The Privatization and Management Office as the "Procuring Entity", through its Bids and Awards Committee (PMO-BAC) intends to apply the sum of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (₱240,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the procurement of Internet Subscription for the year 2010. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of bids.

In accordance with the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Republic Act No. 9184, (RIRR-RA 9184) the bidding for the procurement of Internet Subscription for the year 2010 will be conducted through Negotiated Procurement under Sec. 53 of RIRR-RA 9184, specifically Sub Section 53.9, otherwise known as Small Value Procurement.

The PMO-BAC now invites GPPB registered internet service providers to submit quotations not later than **18 January 2010** for internet subscription based on the following technical specifications.
